Bon Secours Mercy Health operates 49 hospitals and 1,200 sites of care across 6 states in the U.S. and is one of the top five largest Catholic health systems in the country. It also has locations in Ireland.

Commitment to the Vulnerable

The tax-exempt not-for-profit health system is deeply committed to caring for the poor and underserved. Every year, Bon Secours Mercy Health provides over \$600 million in community benefit and charity care versus \$200 million in taxes it would pay. Instead of every \$1 in taxes, Bon Secours Mercy Health spends over \$3 to provide free and discounted medical care as well as services and programs that address food insecurity, transportation and other social determinants of health.

Its charity care program provides free medical services for individuals and families with annual income up to 200% of federal poverty guidelines—or \$62,400 for a family of four. And discounted medical care is provided on a sliding scale for those with annual income up to 400% of federal poverty guidelines—or \$124,800 for a family of four.

High-Quality Care

Many of its hospitals are Magnet® recognized, a designation for excellence in nursing, and frequently receive accolades for patient safety and high standards in care.

Bon Secours Mercy Health continues to maintain strong financial performance, allowing for ongoing investments in improving healthcare access and services.

Focus on Value-Based Care

Bon Secours Mercy Health is recognized for its leadership in value-based care, emphasizing quality outcomes over volume of services, and driving down the overall cost of healthcare while improving patient satisfaction.
