What if I have an existing ongoing recurring gift?

If your gift from a previous campaign is recurring, there's no need to renew for the 2027 pay cycle. If you are interested in modifying your donation, any changes submitted will replace your current gift.

When are payroll deductions taken?

- One time and PTO – November 2026
- Per Pay Period (Power Hour, Half Hour Hero and Lead for Good included) – Starting January 2027, continuing each 2027 pay period.

Can I donate the value of Paid Time Off (PTO)?

Non-exempt (hourly) associates may donate PTO during the campaign. Exempt (salaried) associates are not eligible to donate PTO due to IRS regulations.
